

**“Special” Blue Hill School Committee Meeting

1. Call to Order

2. Approval of the Agenda

3. Business

Each topic was discussed thoroughly and follow up was arranged for specific points. As this was a retreat, no votes were taken.

A. Pre – K discussion

This will be a discussion item on the April agenda.

B. 7-8 MLTI discussion

This will be a discussion item on the May agenda.

C. Math/ELA Curriculum

This will be a follow up item on the April agenda, concerning Math.

There is interest in reviewing our current two Math programs (Everyday Math and Connected Math) along with some other programs which are out there (Singapore Math). If there were to be a change in curriculum, it would have to be phased in, starting in Kindergarten. Math should be an April agenda item. ELA, while important, will follow Math.

D. Extended school day discussion

The extended school day discussion turned into a broader use of time discussion. The Board would like to review the draft or final specialist schedule in June, and have a conversation about time use at school.

E. Grading policy discussion

There was much discussion about grading, and a broad feeling that an M was too great of a range. Perhaps it should be M+ or M-? Perhaps it should be M-86? The Board would like to discuss grading, particularly 6-8 grading, at the April meeting.

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**3. Business (continued)**

- F. Gifted & Talented Enrichment discussion  
Perhaps there needs to be a re-focus on differentiation in the classroom.  
No clear resolution on this difficult topic.
  
- G. The Board would like to review the sports policy again, at the July meeting.
