Yesterday, our students were given a clear picture of what this looks like in action. Middle school science teacher, Nell Herrmann, shared with all of our students some highlights of her trips to Greenland and the science work that she has been doing there since 2009. She presented a slideshow, videos, and artifacts showing what it was like to get there (9 hours on a cargo plane!), what the plants and animals look like there and why, and what data she was collecting while she was there. Our students, right down to the four-year-olds, were engaged throughout the whole presentation. We were so proud of them!
